- 1. In consonance with the Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), our division will conduct a Division Training –Workshop on Contextualizing the Curriculum and Production of Learning Materials For Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED) on December 1-2, 2015 at Sapangbato Elementary School, Sapangbato, Angeles City.
- 2. The Division Training-Workshop aims to build the capacity of teachers and school heads in school serving IP learners in indigenizing the basic education curriculum in partnership with indigenous communities. The indigenized curriculum and learning materials will be the basis for developing indigenized lesson plans which will guide teachers in facilitating a culture-based and culture-responsive teaching-learning process.
- 3. Participants in this training are the Education Program Supervisors, District Supervisors, Principals, Teacher-Writers and Elders of Ayta Mag-Antsi.
- 4. Registration fee, meals and travel expenses of participants relative to this training shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
