

Candidates should be mid-career professionals committed to public service and should have demonstrated ability to achieve positions of significant responsibility and show promise of assuming future leadership roles. Other qualification requirements are in the enclosed information materials about the AY 2018.-2019 Humphrey competition. Dossiers of selected nominees from the Philippines will be reviewed by a selection panel in the U.S. that will make the final selection of successful candidates.
