> Mechanics of the Dance Drama Contest 2017 National Safe Kids Week

What: Dance Drama Contest

When: June 22 (Thursday), 2017 at Sky Dome, SM North Edsa at 2 pm

Who: Open to all Grade III to Grade VI students of the beneficiary schools of Safe Kids Worldwide Philippines in Pasay, Paranaque, Quezon, Angeles and Cebu

Why: The contest is in line with the celebration of the 10th National Safe Kids Week and will portray the problems of safety in the school zone: absence of road signs, non-availability of pedestrian crossing, vendors occupying sidewalk, over speeding (beyond 20 kph) etc.

How:

- 1. The school has to organize a Dance Drama Group with 20 members or less composed of students from Grade III to Grade VI
- 2. The school has to develop a dance drama performance that will run for 3 minutes to a maximum of 5 minutes
- 3. The dance drama should portray the urgent need for safety in the school zone area related to the theme below:

Kids

Theme: #Save^Lives

School - Road - Home

- 4. The City Schools Division Office has to choose 1 dance group to represent the City to the Dance Drama Contest on June 22 (Thursday), 2017 at the Sky Dome, SM City North EDSA
- 5. During the contest, the group should submit a USB copy only for their music
- 6. The winner will be chosen based on the following criteria:
 - Composition (Creativity, artistry, choreography and originality) = 50% a.
 - Execution (Timing &coordination, Projection and expression) =30% b.
 - C. Costume=10%
 - d. Audience impact=10%
- 7. Prizes:

1st Prize= P5.000

2nd Prize=P3,000

3rd Prize= P2,000
