Orientation on Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) Vaccination

To: All PSDS
All Public Elementary Principals/School Heads
All Public Elementary Clinic Teachers

1. Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) is the most common viral infection of the reproductive tract and it's a cause of a range of conditions in both females and males including precancerous lesions which may progress to cervical cancer in women if infection from HPV types 16 & 18 becomes persistent and left untreated hence the WHO recommends girls aged 9-10 years of age and Grade 4 students as target population for HPV vaccination.
2. In line with this, the Department of Health – Region 3 is planning to conduct HPV vaccination to all female Grade 4 enrollees in all Public Elementary Schools in the province of Pampanga & Zambales including component & chartered cities (one of which is Angeles City) come August 2017.
3. The Department of Health will be conducting a half-day orientation regarding HPV vaccination on July 4, 2017, 1 to 5 pm at the Gabaldon Building Jesus St., Pulungbulo, Angeles City.
