2017 NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH

To: Heads of Private and Public Elementary, Secondary and Senior High Schools

1. Executive Order No. 37 (s.1999) mandates the observance of National Disaster Consciousness Month (NDCM). However, in pursuant to Executive Order No. 29 (s.2017), the NDCM shall be renamed the National Disaster Resilience Month to be observed for the whole month of July of every year to promotes the significance of disaster resilience which pertains to the ability of individuals, communities, organizations, and states to adapt to and recover from the effects of hazards and disasters through effective risk management
2. In view of this, the NDRM shall be collectively observed by all Filipinos throughout the country through the conduct of activities relative to building disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas of disasters, namely, disaster prevention and mitigation, disaster preparedness, disaster response, and disaster rehabilitation and recovery.
3. Attached are some of the relevant activities that can be undertaken. All pictures of the activity must be posted at the Facebook account of the DepEd Angeles City and DepEd Angeles City DRRM.
