2017 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

TO: School Heads of Public Elementary and Integrated Schools

1. In support of the K to 12 Program of the Department of Education (DepEd) and with a firm belief that Kindergarten is an essential vehicle in the development of a strong foundation of literacy, this office will conduct a Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents for Public Elementary and Integrated Schools with the theme: "Ako at ang Pamayanan" on February 10, 2017 at Gabaldon Building, Pulung Bulo, Angeles City.
2. The competition aims to:
 - 2.1 showcase the potential of kindergarten children to strengthen their confidence and self-esteem;
 - 2.2 enhance the quality standards of 5-year old children as identified in the activities;
 - 2.3 ensure that the physical, social, emotional intellectual and spiritual personality of young children is developed.
3. The contest categories are as follows:
 - 1.1. Creative Story Telling
 - 1.2. Showcase of Talent (Talentadong Bulilit)
 - 1.3. Drawing
 - 1.4. Dance Calisthenics Competition
4. Enclosed are the general guidelines and the committees for guidance and information.
5. Each district shall conduct their own competitions to select two (2) winners in 1.1 to 1.3 categories and one (1) champion in Calisthenics to qualify in the contest.
6. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

2017 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS
Theme: "Ako at ang Pamayanan"

1. Each district shall conduct their own competitions to select best contestants in all categories.
 2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled kindergarten pupils in public schools.
 3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
 4. Only the district winners per category are qualified to join the contest.
(Creative Story Telling, Drawing and Talentadong Bulilit 1st and 2nd winners will compete in the Division Level, while 1st place winner in calisthenics dance will compete in the division level.)

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

A. CREATIVE STORY TELLING- "Ang Mahiyahing Manok"

Each contestant will be given 3-4 minutes to deliver the piece or story. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

Mastery of the piece	50%
Voice Projection/ verbal style	20%
Characterization.....	20%
(includes posture, facial expressions, variety of dramatic skills displayed)	
Level of Confidence	5%
Costume.....	5%

CALISTHENICS DANCE COMPETITION

Mechanics:
