## DIVISION IMMERSION, SESSION WITH THE ELDERS AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLES - AYTA MAG-ANTSI

1. Immersion, Session with the Elders and Community Engagement for Indigenous Peoples of Ayata Mag-Antsi in the Indigenous Peoples Education Program provide opportunities for interaction and engagement with indigenous cultural communities (ICCs) and learning from existing initiatives on IPED, play an important role in developing perspectives and skills needed in the implementation of the program. The division will conduct the activities on September 15, 2017 from 7 AM to 3 PM at Sitio Target Integrated School, Sitio Target, Angeles City.

2. The objectives of the activities are:

a) To build and strengthen the environment for long term dialogue and partnership and sustained support from both DepEd and the communities themselves.

b) To update the Division on Indigenous Peoples cultural resources, practices, rituals, chants, music, songs and dances, stories, traditional arts and crafts and indigenous games

- c) To create awareness of the different activities to be implemented for the preparation of the orthography and for the implementation of the lesson plans prepared.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the CID Personnel, Principals with Ayta Mag-Antsi Learners and Teacher-Writers, Community Members and Elders of Sitio Target.
- 4. Registration fee, meals and honorarium of elders relative to this training shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
