Attention: Grade 5 Teachers

**“Monitoring of Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of
Dengue Vaccine”**

1. Public Elementary School Children are continuously given 3 doses of Dengue Vaccine called Dengvaxia through the School Based Immunization Program by the Department of Health. Cases of Adverse Events following Immunization (AEFI) were reported which were either recorded or unrecorded.
2. To safeguard the health of our school children who are recipients of Dengvaxia, all public elementary schools are advised to improve AEFI monitoring after vaccination through the following activities.
 - a. Grade five teachers to actively participate in the observation and monitoring of AEFI by immediately reporting absentees to the Rural Health Unit / Health Center Personnel.
 - b. Grade Five Teachers to accurately accomplish the AEFI Daily Monitoring Tool (see attached template) for 30 days after vaccination and immediately report to RHU/HC personnel any reported signs and symptoms from the vaccinated pupils.
3. Questions and/or clarifications with regards to the said activity may be directed to the Health and Nutrition Section of the Division.
4. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum is desired.
