NATIONAL DAY OF PROTEST

To: Office of the Schools Division Superintendent Curriculum Implementation Division School Governance and Operations Division Public and Private Schools



- 1. Please be informed of the attached Memorandum Circular No. 26, s. 2017 about the Proclamation issued by the President declaring September 21, 2017 as a **National Day of Protest**, for **your guidance and reference**.
- 2. Paragraph 3 of the said Memorandum Circular stressed that the suspension of work in private companies and classes in private schools in affected areas is left to the sound dicretion of their respective levels.
- 3. Whereas, Paragraph 2 of DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, entitled "Instituting Measures To Increase Engaged on Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith" underscored that as a matter of policy, the prescribed school days shall be strictly spent on engaged time-on-task.
- 4. In this light, in lieu of September 21, 2017, **all public schools** are required to schedule **make-up classes** by another school day outside the school calendar.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of and stict compliance to this Memorandum is desired.

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 26

In view of the Proclamation issued by the President declaring 21 September 2017 as a National Day of Protest, and the expected public rallies, marches, demonstrations, and other mass actions in various parts of the country, work in government offices, both national and local, and classes in public schools at all levels, including state universities and colleges, are hereby suspended on 21 September 2017.

Agencies whose functions involve the delivery of basic and health services, preparedness/response to disasters and calamities, and/or the performance of other vital services, such as, but not limited to, the Department of Health, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, the Bureau of Fire Protection, and the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, are hereby directed to provide stand-by emergency assistance near protest sites and areas of mass action.

The suspension of work in private companies and classes in private schools in affected areas is left to the sound discretion of their respective heads.
