- 1. As part of the advocacy of this division to strengthen the proficient use of the Kapampangan Language in all public schools, the division will implement the project entitled "AGAP- KAPAMPANGAN", AMANUNG GAMITAN ning ANGELENONG KAPAMPANGAN from Kindergarten to Grade 12. "AGAP-KAPAMPANGAN" shall support the goal of Mother Tongue - Based and Multi Lingual Education as stipulated on DepEd Order No. 16 s. 2012.
- 2. This policy aims to:
 - a. inculcate among learners a sense of pride and love for the Kapampangan Culture as they learn it through the use the Kapampangan Language;
 - b. ensure that every Angeleno speaks and appreciates the Kapampangan Language which is expected to be the first language that they should have learned; and
 - c. develop awareness among our students, teachers and parents on the importance of the language in preserving the culture of Kapampangans.
- 3. AGAP-Kapampangan shall be given fifteen (15) minute time allotment on the Class Program with the activities stated on the attached policy which does not limit the teachers in the exercise of her creativity and resourcefulness.
- 4. To ensure the successful implementation of this policy, an orientation and Capacity Building Seminar will be conducted for teachers and school heads.
- 5. The guidelines on the implementation of this policy program is attached for the information and reference of all concerned.
- 6. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is desired.

GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF "AGAP- KAPAMPANGAN" (AMANUNG GAMITAN Ning ANGELENONG KAPAMPANGAN)

- Pursuant to the provision of DepEd Order no. 16 s. 2012, relative to the implementation of Mother Tongue Based – Multi- Lingual Education (MTB-MLE), DepEd Division of Angeles City will implement a policy on strengthening thye proficient use of Kapampangan Language from Kindergarten to Grade 12 in all public schools;
- 2. This policy shall be called AGAP- KAPAMPANGAN which signifies that as Angelenos, we should act promptly in ensuring that our school children will grow and develop, taking pride in their culture as Kapampangan, which can be manifested through their proficiency in the use of Kapampangan Language
- 3. This policy aims to:
- a. inculcate among learners a sense of pride and love for the Kapampangan Culture as they learn it through the use the Kapampangan Language
- b. ensure that every Angeleno speaks and appreciates the Kapampangan Language which is expected to be the first language that they should have learned; and
- c. develop awareness among our students, teachers and parents ---
- Thus, to realize these objectives the following activities will be undertaken and observed in all public elementary and secondary schools.
 - A. Provision of 15 minutes in the Class Program intended for the lessons on:
 - the socio- cultural heritage of the Angelenos/Kapampangan which shall be discussed to the learners using Kapampangan Language;
 - Kapampangan Songs which shall be aired before and after the Flag Ceremonies and which shall be sung during the Conduct of Homeroom;
 - 3) Story Telling for Grade One as part of the Class Program during the First Semester shall be conducted in Kapampangan
 - B. Observance of Kapampangan Speaking Day
 - C. Kapampangan Cultural Show and Competition featuring the following activities:
 - 1) Poesiang Kapampanagan
 - 2) Polosa
 - 3) Crisotan
 - 4) Kundiman/ Kantang Kapampangan
 - 5) Pyalung Kapampanagan
 - 6) Terak Kapampangan and
 - 7) Other significant activities relevant to Kapampangan Culture
- 5. Capacity Building Seminar will be conducted for teachers and school heads.
