

2017 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

School Kindergarten Coordinators

1. In support of the flagship Program K to 12 of the Department of Education and with the firm belief that Kindergarten is an essential vehicle in the development of a strong foundation of literacy, this office will conduct a Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents for Public Elementary and Private Schools as part of the Education Week celebration on December 5, 2017 at Gabaldon Building, Pulung Bulo, Angeles City.
2. The competition aims to:
 - 2.1 showcase the potential of kindergarten children to strengthen their confidence and self-esteem;
 - 2.2 enhance the quality standards of 5-year old children as identified in the activities;
 - 2.3 ensure that the physical, social, emotional intellectual and spiritual personality of young children is developed; and
 - 2.4 maintain an environment of wholesome relationship between public and private schools.
3. The contest categories are as follows:
 - 1.1. Creative Story Telling
 - 1.2. Picture Book Story Telling
 - 1.3. Showcase of Talent (Little Big Star)
 - 1.4. Drawing and Coloring
 - 1.5. Creative Dance
4. Participants to this activity are the district/private 1st place winners of the different events, and coaches.
5. The general guidelines and criteria for the exhibition are contained in the enclosures of this memorandum.
6. There will be no registration fee to be collected. Expenses such as meals, materials, transportation and other operating expenses of the participants relative to the preparation and conduct of this activity from School Level up to Division Level shall be charged against School MOOE/ and other local funds.
7. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

**GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE
2017 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS
Theme: "Ang Batang Malusog at Masaya, sa Kindergarten Makikita!"**

1. Each district shall conduct their own competitions to select best contestants in all categories.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled kindergarten pupils in public and private schools.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. Only the district/private champions per category are qualified to join the contest.
5. There will be a contest piece for creative storytelling and Picture Book Story Telling and theme for drawing & coloring while the contestants in "*Little Big Star*" are given the freedom to choose their own piece.
 - a. For vocal solo, contestants shall select only one (1) from among the given choices of age-appropriate songs for children. (YESTERDAY'S DREAM by Lea Salonga, THE GREATEST LOVE OF ALL by Whitney Houston, WHAT A WONDERFUL WORLD by Louis Armstrong, or PART OF YOUR WORLD by Ariel-Disney. Tomorrow by Lea Salonga or any appropriate songs for children)
 - b. Coaches are not allowed to stay in front of the stage during the performance of their contestants. STRICTLY NO COACHING SHALL BE OBSERVED WHILE THE CONTEST/PRESENTATION IS GOING ON.
6. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category should be followed strictly.
7. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges.
8. The panel of Judges shall compose of a chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.
9. All winners will receive medal and a certificate of recognition while their coaches will receive a certificate of recognition. All non-winners will be given certificate of participation.

Mechanics of the Contest

A. CREATIVE STORY TELLING

Each contestant will be given 3-4 minutes to deliver the piece or story. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

Mastery of the piece	50%
Voice Projection/ verbal style	20%
Characterization..... (includes posture, facial expressions, variety of dramatic skills displayed)	20%
Level of Confidence	5%
Costume.....	5%

Hu huh u! Ang pagkain ko! Wala na ang aking tanghalian... Hu ! hu! Hu!...

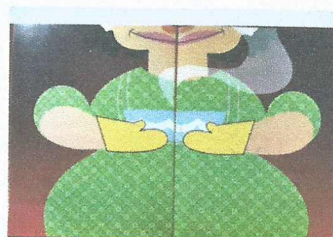
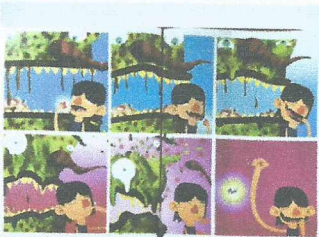
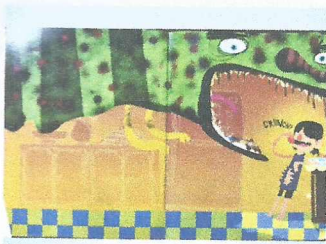
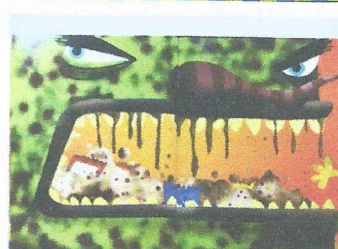
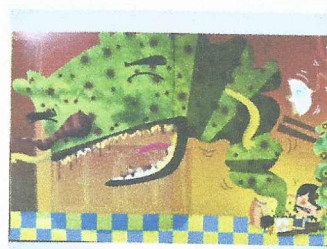
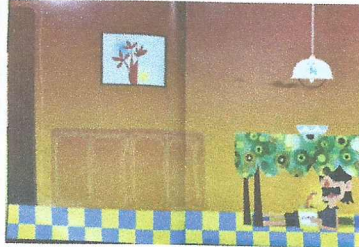
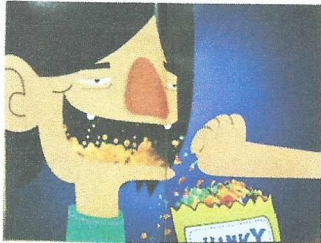
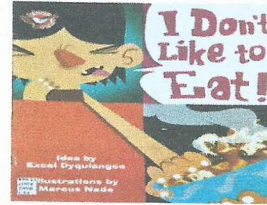

B. PICTURE BOOK STORY TELLING

Our story is about a boy who loves eating junk and shuns nutritious food. He realizes just how bad this is when a junk food-loving monster tries to eat him up.

As you go from one illustration to the next, ask your child what he sees or what he thinks about it. What could the character be saying, thinking, or feeling? What does your child think about how the story progresses or how it ends?



Each contestant will be given 2-3 minutes to deliver the piece or story. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

Interpretation and Delivery of the story.....	50%
Voice Projection/ verbal style	20%
Characterization.....	20%
(includes posture, facial expressions, variety of dramatic skills displayed)	
Level of Confidence	10%

C. CREATIVE DANCE COMPETITION

1. The group is composed of five (5) to ten (10) members (all boys / girls or combination of boys and girls)
2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sport or a combination of sports or Gymnastics movement. (Example if they choose basketball, their steps should include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching).
3. Time of performance should not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
4. Props should be naturally placed on stage during the performance.
5. The winners will be chosen by the panel of judges on the general criteria below:

A. Creativity -	25%
B. Choreography -	20%
C. Grace & Footwork -	25%
D. Mastery & Coordination -	20%
E. Attire -	10%

D. Little Big Star

1. Contestant can choose any of the following talents or any exceptional talents.

A. POETRY RECITATION

Voice Projection	20%
Diction and Enunciation.....	20%
Interpretation of Piece	20%
(includes characterization, posture, facial expression, variety of dramatic skills displayed, costumes, props, etc..)	
Memorization	20%
Poise and stage presence	20%

B. VOCAL SOLO

1. Each contestant is free to choose any appropriate songs for children.
2. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment;
However, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment/ acapella

E. DRAWING AND COLORING

1. Each contestant will draw on one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) sheet of illustration board using pencil and crayons within 1 hour.
2. Contestant will bring their own material to be used during the contest
3. Illustration board will be provided during the contest.
4. The drawing depicts the theme given. There will be three themes given and only one (1) will be announced during the contest.
 - a. " Beauty of Nature
 - b. " Happy Family"
 - c. " Healthy Surrounding"
