## DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE PRACTICES IN KINDERGARTEN EDUCATION PROGRAM (KEP) SEMINAR WORKSHOP FOR SCHOOL HEADS AND KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS

Heads of Public Elementary and Integrated Schools To Kindergarten Teachers

- In the advent that RA 10157 or Kindergarten Education Act is Implemented, this makes kindergarten level mandatory and compulsory for all 5 years old children and pursuant to the Deped Order No. 47, s. 2016 Omnibus Policy on Kindergarten Education that the State make education responsive to the needs, circumstances, and diversity of learners, schools, and communities using developmentally appropriate and culturally sensitive practices. A seminar workshop for untrained kindergarten teachers and schools heads will be held on November 27. 28 and 29, 2017 at the Sto Rosario ES Conference Hall, Angeles City.
- The objectives of the seminar workshop are as follows: 2.
  - a) To acquire deeper understanding on the goals, objectives and curriculum and program of activities of pre school education needed in their provision of technical assistance to kindergarten teachers:
  - b) To update Kindergarten teachers on the National Kindergarten Curriculum Guide (NKCG), Curriculum Guide (CG) and the new Kindergarten Teacher's Guide (KTG);
  - c) To enhance teacher's capability in teaching, making instructional materials that are developmentally appropriate for kindergarten pupils;
  - d) To revisit Kindergarten Assessment Tools using Formative and Summative, ECD Checklist and Progress Report Card and its implementation.
- The participants in this seminar workshop are untrained kindergarten teachers and school heads. Each school is entitled to send 2 participants. (1 school head and 1 kindergarten teacher)
- Lunch, snacks and other incidental expenses for this activity of the participants shall be charged to the Division INSET - Current funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired. 5.
