INTERPRETATI VE DANCE for Elementary Level

- 1. Interpretative Dance competition is open to all bonafide elementary pupils of Angeles City.
- 2. Each participating school can submit only one entry.
- 3. There shall be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 performers.
- 4. Each entry shall be in- line with the theme "Mad Against Dangerous Drugs"
- 5. Each participating school is free to use foreign or Filipino music
- 6. Performance shall be limited from 5-8 minutes, including entrance and exit.
- 7. Fireworks and other pyrotechnic materials are not allowed.
- 7. Criteria for judging are as follows. Performance (choreography, precision and execution) 35% Relevance to the theme 30% Timing and Coordination 25% Costume and Props 10% Total 100%
- 8. Three winners will be chosen by the judges. They will be awarded as Champion 1st Runner up and 2nd Runner Up.
- 9. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

Mechanics and Criteria for the MAMAYAN AYAW SA DROGA Poster Making

This Poster Making is part of the MADD FEST Division Wide Anti-Dangerous Drugs Awareness Campaign. The opening ceremony for the MADD FEST will be held at Angeles City Science High School on November 29, 2017at 8:00 AM.

A. Mechanics

- 1. The MADD FEST Poster Making Contest is open to all bonafide elementary pupils from the Division of Angeles City. There will be one (1) representative only per school.
- 2. All interested participants must have a pre-registration before the said event.
- 3. The theme for the poster making shall be: "Ang Pakikinig sa mga bata o Kabataan ay Daan Upang Tulungan Silang Lumaki na Malusog at Ligtas".
- $4. \frac{1}{2}$ illustration board for each participant will be provided by the organizers. Pastel colors must be brought by the participants during the contest day.
- 5. All artworks must be done on the spot and must be completed within the allotted time of two hours.
- 7. All entries will be pre-numbered. No other identifying marks will be allowed to appear in the artworks.
- 8. All entries shall be judged by a Board of Judges from the Division Office.
- 9. All outputs shall be kept by the organizers and shall be used for other advocacy activities.
- 10. Contest day shall be on November 29, 2017, 8:00 AM, at Clemendes Elementary School.
- 11. Winners will be identified at the end of the activity.

B. Criteria for Judging

All artworks will be judged based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme -40%

- ·Creativity and Presentation -40%
- ·Originality -20%

MECHANICS AND CRITERIA for ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

This Essay Writing Contest is part of the activities for the MADD FEST Division Wide Anti-Dangerous Drugs Awareness Campaign

Mechanics:

- 1. The MADD FEST Essay Writing Contest is open to all bonafide elementary pupils from the Division of Angeles City. There will be one (1) representative only per school.
- 2. All interested participants must have a pre-registration before the said event.
- 3. All entries must be written in Filipino and must have at least 250 words and must not exceed to 400 words.
- 4. All entries must be original and previously unpublished.
- 5. All entries will be judged based on content, originality, structure and style.
- 6. All entries must follow the specification below:
- -Paper: provided by the organizers
- -Margin: 1 inch margin on each side
- -Contains at least three (3) paragraphs
- 7. The participants shall be given one (1) hour to write and finish their essay.

Structure 20%

Adherence to Topic 10%

Grammar 10%

Length 10%

Originality 10%
