**2017 NATIONAL READING MONTH READING CAMP**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors  
Division English Coordinator  
School Heads of Public Elementary and High Schools

1. This is to announce the holding of the **Reading Camp** in celebration of the **2017 National Reading Month (NRM)** at Angeles City National High School, Pampang, Angeles City on November 29, 2017.
2. With the theme, "A Celebration of Arts and Culture through Reading", the celebration aims to:
  - a. support the DepEd Ten-Point Agenda 2017-2022 entitled Quality, Accessible, Relevant and Liberating Basic Education for All;
  - b. strengthen the DepEd's Every Child A Reader Program, making every Filipino child a competent reader and writer appropriate for his/her grade level; and
  - c. commemorate the centennial of the birth anniversary of Nick Joaquin, National Artist for Literature
3. The following are the different division contests to culminate the celebration:
  - a. Grade 4 - On the Spot Poster Making Contest - (3 contestants per District)
  - b. Grade 5 - Interpretative Dance (1 Team per District)
  - c. Grade 6 - Quiz Bee (3 Teams per District with 3 members)
  - d. Grade 7 - On the Spot Reading Contest (1 contestant per High School)
  - e. Grade 8 - News Writing Contest (1 contestant per High School)
  - f. Grade 9 - \*Comic Strip Competition (1 contestant per High School)
  - g. Grade 10 - On the Spot Storytelling Contest (1 contestant per High School)
  - h. Grade 11 - \*Reading Challenge Contest (1 contestant per Senior High School)
  - i. Grade 12 - One Paragraph Short Story Writing Contest (1 contestant per SHS)

\*Contests with Regional and National levels

4. As part of the celebration, the evaluation for Bulletin Board Making Contest to highlight this year's theme will be on December 1, 2017.
5. An amount of one hundred pesos (P100.00) shall be collected from each contestant and the coach of each contest category, including every member and coach in the Quiz Bee. Meanwhile, each team for Interpretative Dance will pay an amount of five hundred pesos (P500) only as registration fee for the whole team. The collected amount will be used to cover the expenses for the trophies, certificates, meals/snacks of the judges/ members of the committee and other incidental expenses to be charged to School MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing procedure.
6. Registration starts at 7:30 am to be followed by an Opening Program at 8:00 am.
