- 1. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533, Section 10.4 (Medium of teaching and Learning), mandates DepEd to develop proficiency in Filipino and English, provided that the first dominant language of the learners shall serve as the fundamental language of education. In support of this mandate, the division will conduct the "Division Re-Orientation Workshop on Orthography Development and Continuation on Development of Lesson Plans for Indigenous Peoples Ayta Magantsi" on March 23-24, 2017 at Sapangbato Elementary School, Sapangbato, Angeles City.
