

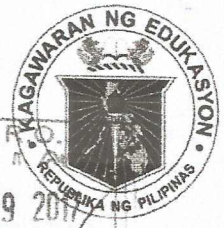

- enhance the teaching competencies of private pre-elementary and elementary school teachers geared towards developing 21st century skills among their students



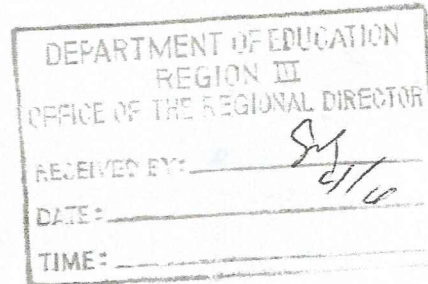

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
