The Seoul Peace Prize was created in February 1990 to commemorate the success of the 24th Seoul Olympic Games held in Seoul in September 1988, an event widely recognized for its historic contribution to global peace and harmony. In the Seoul Olympics, 160 nations all over the world got together for the first time in many years, thus paving the way for East-West detente and world peace.

The objective of the Seoul Peace Prize is to encourage and recognize an individual(s) or institution(s) for endeavors contributing to the development of a more peaceful world and to the fostering of friendly relations, mutual understanding and reconciliation among peoples and nations.

The Seoul Peace Prize is an international prize awarded biennially. The laureate receives a diploma, a plaque and an honorarium of US\$200,000. Distinguished figures and institutions at home and abroad are asked to nominate candidates for the prize.

Nominees, as persons or organizations in being, should deserve indisputable recognition for their outstanding contribution in the following areas:

- Maintenance or restoration of peace in a disputed region or the world at large
- Promotion of understanding and reconciliation among peoples and nations
- Human development projects or initiatives
- Peace building through the advancement of human rights, democracy, feminism, environment, culture, sports, and science and technology
