

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 218 s. 2017

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents Regional Division Chiefs All Others Concerned



PARENTS AND OTHER EXTERNAL STAKEHOLDERS' FUND GENERATING **ACTIVITIES FOR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**

- 1. The Department of Education recognizes the strong potential of parents and other external stakeholders in generating financial resources to support Division School Superintendent programs. In fact, the mission statement of the department clearly articulates the said supportive partnership.
- 2. The School-Based Management as stipulated in DepEd Order 83 s. 2012 recognizes the important contributions of stakeholders. The principles of Collective Leadership and Governance and Convergence to Human Resources for Education affirm the strong justification on their involvement for school improvement projects.
- 3. Anchored to DepEd Order 54, s. 2009, the Parents-Teachers Association are allowed to generate funds to support their identified priorities for school improvement. But the generation of funds must not dwell in any activity that will require the involvement of the teachers and pupils/students.
- 4. To sustain the synergical relationship between parents and other external stakeholders and the school, the former are allowed to undertake their fund raising activities but must conform with the following conditions:
 - a. School heads and teachers should not be involved in the collection or safekeeping and disbursement of the raised funds. The functions of the PTA must still be observed as articulated in DepEd Order 54 S. 2009.
 - b. Pupils/students should not, in any way, be involved in the fund generating activity (e.g. selling and paying tickets)

- c. External stakeholders like civic spirited individuals and groups, business firms and alumni, in coordination with the Alumni, Association Officers, must be tapped for the fund generating activities.
- d. Officers of the PTA must present complete and transparent financial statement during their assembly to protect their integrity as an organization.
- 5. It must be made very clear that this Office protects impoverished families who have nothing except to enjoy their constitutional right for free basic education, thus, fund generating activities in schools should not be an additional burden to them which will lead to the deprivation of the said right.
- 6. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this memorandum is directed.
