5TH CENTRAL LUZON REGION KAB-O-REE

To: Heads of Public and Private Elementary Schools

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 14, s. 2018, the Central Luzon Region III will be holding the 5th Central Luzon Regional KAB-O-Ree on October 25-28, 2018 at Fortunato F. Halili National High School, Sta. Maria Bulacan.

2. Aims and Objectives.

The KAB-O-REE aims to provide an environment of learning, safe and enjoyable to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. By the end of the jamboree the scouts would be able to;

- a. Undergo activities that will enable them to complete requirement for the Growing USA rank.
- b. Undertake environmental activities that will promote awareness of their role as young people towards environment under the Better World Programs.
- c. Develop skills and capabilities through team buildings activities, games group dynamic, creativity, character building and critical thinking.

3. Qualifications:

3. Scouts

- a. Registered KAB Scout
- b. Must be grade 3 or eight (8) years old and above
- c. Must be at least Young USA Award

3. Adult Leaders

- a. Registered Unit Leaders for at least two (2) years and have adequate camping experience
- b. Physically fit as certified by a physician .

4. The estimated expenses per delegate are broken down as follows.


a. Registration Fee	P 500.00
b. Meals for 4 days	<u>500.00</u>
Total	P 1,000.00

5 Transportation of the participants will be provided by the Council and the registration fee (P500.00) of the Adult leaders shall be charge to school MOOE.

6. Teacher must coordinate with their principal in such way that their classes will not be disrupted and that another teacher will handle their classes.

7. It is emphasized that the participation of this activities is strictly on a voluntary basis.

Subject: **5th CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL KAB-O-REE**

1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the 5th Central Luzon Regional KAB-O-REE on 25-28 October 2018 at Fortunato F. Halili National High School, Sta. Maria, Bulacan.

2. **Aims & Objectives.**

The KAB-O-REE aims to provide an environment of learning, safe and enjoyable to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. By the end of the jamboree the scouts would be able to:

- 2.a Undergo activities that will enable them to complete requirements for the Growing USA rank
- 2.b. strengthen the role parent in the KAB Scouting section and enhanced partnerships with the Kawan Leaders and other adult leaders in the unit
- 2.c undertake environmental activities that will promote awareness of their roles as young people towards environment under the Better World Programs
- 2.d Develop skills and capacities through team building activities, games, group dynamics, creativity, character building and critical thinking.

3. **Qualification:**

3.a **Scout**

- registered KAB Scouts
- must be grade 3 or eight years old and above
- must be at least Young USA Award

3.b **Adult Leaders**

- registered Unit Leader for at least two years and have adequate camping experience
- physically fit as certified by a physician and of good moral character

3.c **Regional Service Team**

The Regional Office in collaboration with the Council Scout Executive of Bulacan Council will accept Regional Service Team, however interested applicants shall apply directly with their Council Scout Executives who shall endorse it to the regional office. Minimum requirement shall be at least graduate of Advanced Training Course for Kawan Leaders. This excludes program staff for the Better World Programs where other are trained with Troop Leaders & Outfit Advisors.

4. Registration Details

4.a **Registration Fee**

A registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) shall be charged each participant to defray administrative costs, program materials, souvenir items and other operating expenses.

4.b **Registration Guidelines**

In order to provide Bulacan Council the much needed logistical and administrative preparation, a reservation fee of Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) shall be deposited to the account of the Bulacan Council on or before 15 October which will serve as seed money for the jamboree. This also will determine the strength of the participation and to give ample time for the preparation of program materials, souvenir items and other administrative concern.

Should there be additional registration after the deadline of the payment of registration, they would be treated the least priority on all issuances but can attend the activities/modules of the KAB-O-Ree.

4.c **Participation Ratio:**

A minimum ratio of 1 adult leader in every four boys shall be observed (one shall be a parent who is member of the unit committee). This is to

minimize the number of adults in the camp and providing the scouts the opportunity to prepare their own meals and orderliness in the camp.

5. Travel Itinerary

All council KAB-O-Ree contingents must be settled in the camp not later than 1200hrs, 24 October 2018 and will only be allowed to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremonies and issuance of Camp Clearance.

6. Food & other Jamboree Provisions

The Council Contingent shall make sure that the food provision and other basic requirements shall be adequate for the duration of the jamboree. Wet and dry markets will be available in the camp.

For light & water provisions, all council contingents shall bring their own water containers (big) and wire/extensions. Source or power will only be installed in strategic locations.

7. All Council Scout Executives/Officers-In-Charge are enjoined to promote the jamboree to all districts/schools in their respective councils. They should also be responsible for the official release of their delegation from their respective division.
