- 6. All schools should strictly follow the No School Paper, No Student Contestant Policy.
- Submission of school paper entries will be on or before Nov. 08, 2018 and certificates of wide circulation must be attached to the entries. Schools that collected journalism or subscription fees are required to submit school paper entries and not PDF files.
- In recognition and respect for Intellectual Property Rights, plagiarism is strongly discouraged, thus, school paper published in printed or pdf forms found to have copied and published texts, graphs, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources shall be disqualified.
- Registration starts at 7:30 am to be followed by a mini opening program. RSPC coaches are not required to be at the training venue but are requested to attend a meeting on RSPC matters on Nov. 15,2018 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon.
