

- 1. The 2018 Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association (CLRAA) Meet is scheduled on February 25 to March 2, 2018 at the Bulacan Sports Complex, Sta. Isabel, City of Malolos, Bulacan.
- 2. The Angeles City Delegation will be billeted at Santissima Trinidad Elementary School and Santissima Trinidad High School, Malolos, Bulacan.
- 3. The departure of the delegates will be on February 24, 2018 (Saturday) at 12:00 N.N.,
 Division of Angeles City and their return will be on March 2, 2018 (Friday) at 6:00 P.M.,
 Division of Angeles City. The Engineering, Quarters and Supply Officials will leave on
 February 23, 2018 at 12:00 N.N. to prepare the billeting quarters.
- 4. The **Solidarity Meeting** of all athletes, coaches and technical management committee will be on **February 20, 2018**, 1:00 P.M., **Gabaldon**, **Building**.

- 5. All sports officials must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (DepEd Child Protection Policy). As such, they shall be held responsible for the protection, welfare and safety of their athletes. Therefore, close supervision shall be observed in the entire duration of the event. Students/Pupils should not be permitted to wander off on their own.
- Likewise, sports officials should also continue to promote the consumption of healthy food and beverages pursuant to the DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017.
- All concerned schools are expected to extend their full support to their students who have been selected to participate in the 2018 CLRAA and presently undergoing the training. In the same manner, they are hereby enjoined to comply with the mandates of Education Act of 1982, Rule III, Section 3, (e) that teachers shall refrain from making deductions in the scholastic rating of pupils/students, for any act that is clearly not a manifestation of poor scholarship and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, Paragraph 2, (b) uphold child protection policy principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form.
- 8. Special assistance should be given to students/pupils such as **catch up learning sessions:** (advanced lessons, special tests, self learning modules, and the like), as per DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017.
- 9. In the same manner, support shall be given by their teachers and make necessary arrangements in accordance with the DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith" and strict compliance with 180 days Teaching and Learning Guidelines.
- 10. Service Credits shall be granted as stipulated in DECS Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. Non-Teaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance to Civil Service

Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

- 11. To clarify all these concerns and consolidate all ideas, all coaches and technical management committee will have a Final Planning Meeting on February 9, 2018 at 1:00 P.M., Sto. Rosario Elementary School, Conference Hall.
- 12. Attached is the list of coaches and technical management committee.
- 13. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
