This year, our Alay Kapwa Fund Drive was able to mobilize a total of **P3,152,401.16**. These funds were used for our various humanitarian services.

- 116 college scholars and 9 scholars under the Dual Training System of Education in partnership with Our Lady of Mt. Carmel College were assisted for SY 2017-2018;
- 24 college and 5 DTSE scholars graduated this school year bringing to 303 the total graduates since the program started in 1996; most of the graduates are social workers, teachers, architects and engineers, business management and accountants who are now gainfully employed and helping their respective families; and
- 974 poor patients were provided with quality health care services through our medical and dental
 missions and clinic, 98 were served by our regular summer Operation Tuli, and 39 walk-in were
 referred to our partner doctors' clinic and medical institutions.

Greetings of Grace and Peace!

The launching of this year's *Alay Kapwa* Archdiocesan Lenten Action Program will be on 14 February 2018, Ash Wednesday. A Eucharistic Celebration will be held at the Metropolitan Cathedral at 9:00 AM, with Most Rev. Florentino G. Lavarias, D.D. presiding.

To raise funds for the *Alay Kapwa* Program, *Alay Kapwa* envelopes will be distributed in parishes and schools in our Archdiocese; *Alay Kapwa* cans/coin banks will be distributed among participating families, business establishments, schools, government institutions and some parishes too. Lastly, the *Alay Kapwa* Sunday Second Collection held annually during **Palm Sunday** will be observed in all parishes on **25 March 2018**.

All funds are to be remitted to the Finance Department at the Arzobispado de Pampanga or to SACOP not later than 13 April 2018. The funds raised will be utilized for the following:

Programs:

- a. Scholarship grants and educational privileges in college and vocational-technical courses for 200 poor students each year;
- A medical clinic that gives access to quality health care services through referrals to our doctor-clinic and hospital partners, quarterly medical and dental missions in far communities;
- c. Free surgeries for harelip and cleft palate, pterygium and caratact patients in partnership with Operation Smile and Cataract Missions respectively;
- d. Provision of prosthesis, crutches and wheelchairs in partnership with Walking-free Pampanga and;
- e. Immediate response in times of calamities through disaster monitoring and emergency relief assistance in coordination with the disaster prone parishes.

Evangelization Campaign activities:

a. Trainors' Training on *Alay Kapwa* module on 10 February 2018 (Saturday) with the Chairperson of the Ministry on Formation and 2 Catechist Representatives from each parish at SACOP Ephatha Development Center.

b. Distribution of Alay Kapwa modules and other materials to be used in the parish

evangelization and formation activities.

Let us all wholeheartedly support the *Alay Kapwa* Program as a manifestation of our love for the poor. Thank you for the kind attention.
