To complement the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) as a national policy reform aimed at developing its human capital, the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (BFROD) and the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in collaboration with the Philippine National Research Center for Teacher Quality (RCTQ) initiated the review and enhancement of the current National Competency-based Standards for School Heads (NCBS-SH) to address career progression and current thinking about school heads in the 21st century. A similar set of professional standards for supervisors has also been developed.

The draft Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (hereinatter referred to as PPSSH) and the draft Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors (hereinafter referred to as PPSS) have been validated in seven (7) regions (NCR, IV-A, V, VI, VII, VIII, and X) as of February 2019. In order to capture the views and aspirations of the professions at the national level, and to further refine the drafts, another round of validation shall be conducted to further gather quantitative and qualitative data. This shall be conducted by BHROD, NEAP, and the composite team comprised of RCTQ and the DepEd Technical Working Group (see Enclosure #2 for the national validation assignments). Please take note of the following activity details:

## Second and Third Validation Activity Description

The second validation (hereinafter referred to as Survey) and third validation (hereinafter referred to as FGW or Focus Group Workshop) of PPSSH and PPSS are set to be administered to To regions from mid-July to August 2019. The Regional Human Resource Development Division (RO-HRDD) shall coordinate with the selected participants, BHROD, and RCTQ on relevant preparations including the identification of venue for the said activities. The second

and third validation will run for two (2) days. The Survey may be conducted on the first day and the FGW on the second day (Schedule A), or vice versa (Schedule B), as follows:

Note: There shall be provision for snacks and lunch for both Schedule A and B. Breakfast and dinner will be screed for those with accommodation/come from distant areas.

## **Expected Participants**

Participants have been randomly selected based on the sample size and criteria provided by RCTQ. Randomly selected incumbent school heads (i.e. Principal I to IV) and supervisors, including Chief Education Program Supervisors, Education Program Supervisors, and Public District Supervisors from the Regional Office and Schools Division Office are expected to participate in the validation. The set of participants in the Survey shall be different from the participants in the FGW. Randomly selected participants who were already part of the first validation shall automatically be replaced.

Interested members of accredited associations of school heads and supervisors may also participate by coordinating with their respective Regional Office. The Regional Office shall identify representatives of the said associations. The number of representatives must be within the acceptable random sample size allotted per region.

DepEd Regions IX and X are requested to accommodate nearby Schools Division Offices (SDO) from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) Ministry of Basic, Higher, Technical Education who may wish to participate in the validation.
