ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST FOR THE 2019 WORLD FOOD DAY CELEBRATION

To: Heads of Public Elementary Schools

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 2019 WORLD FOOD DAY NATIONAL AND REGIONAL ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTESTS

The Department of Agriculture (DA) is honored and privileged to once again partner with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) in celebrating this year's WFD with the theme, "Our actions are our future. Healthy diets for a #ZeroHunger world."

The annual On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest has been one of the highlights of the WFD celebration, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd). The activity will involve elementary pupils from Grades IV to VI, who are enrolled in any public and Dep-Ed-accredited private elementary schools nationwide.

The WFD Regional On-the Spot Poster Making Contests will be conducted from August to September 2019 in the respective regions, while the National contest will be on **October 15, 2019** in Quezon City.

The following is the set of guidelines for the said event:

I. General Provisions

The following are the general provisions for the On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest:

- The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEdaccredited private schools nationwide. Previous national winners of this contest need not join.
- Only one (1) contestant per region, endorsed by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee will be qualified to join the National On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest.
- 3. Students shall be allowed to have one (1) coach and one (1) guardian.
- 4. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot at the regional and national levels. (Division/District level contest may be conducted provided that expenses to be incurred shall be shouldered by the DepEd or DA regional offices).
- 5. Contestants are not allowed to bring their own materials. Materials to be used for the Poster Making Contest shall be limited to an illustration board (20" x 30"), eight (8) color oil pastel (i.e. red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, brown, black) and pentel pen to be provided by the Contest Committee during the regional and national contests.
- The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
- Judging shall immediately commence after all entries have been submitted. Coaches, guardians
 and participants will not be allowed to enter the contest venue while evaluation of the Board of
 Judges (BOJ) is on-going.
- The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven to commit any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating), the title and the prize shall be withdrawn.
- 9. All entries shall become the property of the DA and FAO.
- 10. Winning entries will be displayed during the culminating activities of the WFD Celebration on October 16, 2019 at the Liwasang Aurora Memorial Circle, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City. Best Posters will be awarded on the same event.
- 11. Winners of the Best Poster will receive a cash prize, trophy, and certificate of recognition.

II. Criteria For Judging:

The Board of Judges (BOJ) shall preside the adjudication of entries based on the following criteria:

III. Contest Proper: (National)

- A three-hour period shall be allotted for the On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest without any time extension;
- A sub-theme will be announced on the contest day. Contestant and coach will be allowed to confer for 30 minutes before the contest proper starts.
- 3. Coaches and guardians are strictly prohibited inside the venue during the contest proper;
- 4. Each participant shall be required to submit a brief description/explanation of the finished poster written either in Filipino or English with a maximum of 100 words. The description will be written in the form provided by the Contest Committee to be pasted at the back of the poster.
- After the submission of artwork, participants shall leave the contest venue for the judging of the BOJ;
- 6. The BOJ shall select the Best 5 posters from among the entries.

The National contest and judging will be held on October 15, 2019, 8:00 A.M to 12 P.M. in Quezon City. While the Awarding Ceremony will be held on October 16, 2019 at the Liwasang Aurora at the Quezon Memorial Circle.


