CREW LEADERS TRAINING COURSE

To: Heads of Public and Private, Integrated Secondary Schools

- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines will conduct Crew Leaders Training Course on September 20-22, 2019 (
 Friday to Sunday) at BSP Training Center, Angeles City with the theme: "Commitment to Excellence."
- The objectives of the Course are as follow:
 - Demonstrate typical Senior Scout activities and the need for intelligent coordination of effort through leadership;
 - B. Realize the necessity of discipline and good order;
 - Demonstrate the technique of learning by doing through immediate application of newly acquired Scouting Skills;
 - D. Provide leadership experience to scout;
 - E. Train the Senior Scouts to become effective leaders in their respective schools.
- 3. **GENERAL QUALIFICATION:** For an individual to qualify to participate in the Crew Leaders Training Course, the following standards must be met.
 - A. Currently registered Senior Scout.
 - B. Grade 7-10 student.
 - C. Has an official neckerchief and slide
 - D. Physically fit.
 - E. With parental consent
 - F. Accompanied by Outfit Leaders
- 4. The participants are required to bring the following:
 - A. Tent
 - B. Personal gear, white T-shirt, extra t-shirt , rubber shoes , slipper
 - C. Toiletries, personal effect, off lotion, dishwashing liquid
 - D. Spoon, Fork, Plate, Plastic Glass, trash bag, bowl
- 5. **PARTICIPATION**: Each sponsoring institution must have a minimum of 6 and maximum of 10 participants and a potential Crew Leader. Participants are required to report at the venue on September 20, Friday at 9:00 A.M.
- 6. **REGISTRATION FEE**: A registration fee of four hundred pesos **(Php 400.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the board and lodging, food,,training materials and supplies, and other operations expenses.
- 7. Acknowledging the participation of the students in this training course contributes to their holistic development. Make-up classes should be arranged by their respective class advisers and school principals to ensure minimal class description.
- 8. Likewise, all teachers involved in this training course should make necessary arrangements with their principals to ensure compliance with DepEd Order No. 9 s., 2005 entitled "Instituting measure to increase time on task and ensuring compliance therewith and strict with 180 days Teaching and Learning Guidelines."
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
