- In order to strengthen the capacity of DepEd in responding to IP learning needs in a manner that is flexible, demand-driven and evidence-based, our division will hold a Division Retooling for Teachers, School Heads and Supervisors and Consultative and Advisory Body for Indigenous Peoples Education on October 3 - 4, 2019, 8AM to 5PM at Sitio Target Integrated School, Sapangbato, Angeles City.
