The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized, and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize, indigenize, and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities.

3. The objectives of the project are:


3.1 To develop the competencies needed in contextualizing the curriculum responsive to the indigenous community being served; and

4. Participants to this training write-shop are the Division IPED Focal Person, Division Alternate IPED Focal Person, Principals with IP Learners, selected Teachers and CAB Officers.

4. Registration fee, meals and travel expenses of participants relative to this session shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
