1. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized, and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize, indigenize, and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities.

- 2. In support of this mandate, a "Division Training-Write-shop on the Development of Learning Materials Cum Editing and Printing" will be conducted on November 6 8, 2019 and November 20--22, 2019 form 8AM to 5PM at Sapangbato Elementary School, Angeles City.

- 4. Registration fee, meals and travel expenses of participants relative to this session shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
