- 1. Sessions with the Consultative and Advisory Body of the Ayta Mag-Antsi provide opportunities to interact, engage with indigenous cultural communities (ICCs) and learning from existing initiatives on IPEd which are needed in developing perspectives and skills in the implementation of the program. They also focus on important issues for the indigenization of the curriculum and seek or sustain support on the program especially in preserving their culture. Interviews are also part of the activity to be needed in the enhancement of the framework. In relation to this, the divison shall conduct the last session "The Division Session with the CAB for IPED of Ayta Mag-antsi" which will be held on November 28, 2019 at Sitio Target Integrated School, Angeles City from 7 AM to 2 PM.
- 2. The objectives of the session with the CABs are as follows:
- a) To build and strengthen the environment for long term dialogue and partnership and to sustain support from both DepEd and the communities themselves; and
- b) To create awareness on the different activities to be implemented for the indigenization and localization of their curriculum and enhancement of the framework.
- 3. Participants to this session are the selected CID, SGOD, Division IPED Focal Person, Division Alternate IPED Focal Person, principals with IP Learners, teachers with IP learners and CAB Officers and Elders.
- 4. Registration fee, meals and travel expenses of participants relative to this activity shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
