DIVISION VALIDATION AND FIELD TESTING OF IPED LEARNING MATERIALS (Big Books and Lesson Plans) OF AYTA MAG-ANTSI

1. As part of the quality assurance of the indigenization of learning materials for Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd), a field test of an initial 2-3 lesson plans using the learning materials developed shall be undertaken. The objective is to gather feedback that will serve as basis for further development of the targeted learning materials for the first two quarters in selected learning areas. The field test is thus a prerequisite to making all the other learning materials to be submitted.

The field test shall primarily look into the needed enhancements in the indigenization of learning materials. While suggestions may arise regarding the usual parameters when doing classroom observation, the primary concern in the field test is to gather suggestions on how to improve the indigenization process. The division will conduct the "Division Validation and Field Testing of IPED Learning Materials cum Session with the CAB for Ayta Mag-Antsi" on December 9 -10, 2019 at Sitio Target Integrated School from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

- The objectives of the validation and field test are as follows:
 - a) to primarily look into the needed enhancements in the indigenization of Learning Materials;
 - b) to suggest on the usual parameters when doing classroom observation; and
 - c) to improve the indigenization process.
- 3. Participants to this field test are the selected EPS, Principals with IP Learners, Selected Teachers and CAB Officers.
- 4. Registration fee, meals and travel expenses of participants relative to this activity shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
