

Division Elimination of Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge (MMC)

To: Heads of Public and Private Schools

- 1. This is to announce the conduct of the **Division Elimination of Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge (MMC)** which will be held on January 16, 2020 for the Elementary Level and January 17, 2020 for the Junior Level at the Lourdes Northwest Elementary School.
- 2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute to improving the quality of mathematics education in Angeles City . Specifically, it aims to:
 - a. awaken greater interest in Mathematics among Elementary and Junior High School learners in both public and private schools all over Angeles City;
 - b. encourage students to strive for excellence in Mathematics;
 - c. encourage mastery of the basic mathematical skills:
 - d. discover mathematical talents among the students;
 - e. develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and
 - f. provide students with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
- 3. Registration of participants will start at 7:00AM and a short program starts at 7:30 AM. This will be followed by an orientation regarding contest mechanics as well as the opening publicly the package of test questions to be witnessed by the school division representative, coaches and students.
- 4. All coaches are required to bring a copy of the email confirmation form (MMC form 1) that will serve as permit of participating schools and students.

- 5. Contestants must wear their prescribed school uniform for proper recognition among the learners/students during the entire flow of the contest.
- 6. Participants in this elimination are grades 1 to 10 learners, coaches, contest administrators and District Mathematics Coordinators.
- 7. Meals for Judges, contest administrators and other expenses relative to this activity will be charged against Division INSET Funds while the transportation expenses and food allowance of the participants will be charged against school MOOE and/or canteen/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
