> ONLINE DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP OF TEACHER-WRITERS ON THE UTILIZATION OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES ORTHOGRAPHY, ALPHABET PRIMER AND DEVELOPMENT OF LEARNING MATERIALS OF AYTA MAG-ANTSI

- 1. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533, Section 10.4 (Medium of Teaching and Learning), mandates DepEd to develop proficiency in Filipino and English provided that the first and dominant language of the learners shall serve as the fundamental language of education. For kindergarten and the first three years of elementary education, instruction, teaching materials and assessment shall be in the regional and native language of the learners. In support to this mandate, the Division shall conduct the Online Division Training-Workshop of Teacher-Writers on the Utilization of Indigenous Peoples Orthography, Alphabet Primer and Development of Learning Materials of Ayta Mag-antsi on December 2 - 4, 2020 on google meet from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- 2. The training aims to equip participants on the development of supplementary learning materials based on the language of the Indigenous cultural community (Ayta-Mag-antsi) to be used for Kinder up to Grade 3.
- 3. The participants are the Division IPED Focal and Alternate Focal Persons, School Principals with IP Learners, IPED Teacher-Writers and select Culture Bearers. Each participant in the said training is required to have either or both hard copy or soft copy of the validated and field-tested alphabet primer and Marungko for IP Learners and internet connectivity. All expenses of the training shall be charged to IPED Program Support Funds subject to the accounting and auditing regulations.
