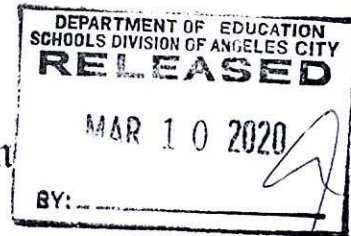

SUSPENSION OF THE 2020 CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CLRAA) MEET AND ITS RELATED ACTIVITIES

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent and Unit Heads
Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division
Chief, School Governance and Operations Division
Heads of Public and Private Elementary, Junior and Senior High Schools

1. Pursuant to Department Memorandum No. 034, s. 2020, dated March 9, 2020, titled "Fifth Set of Policy Directives of DepEd Task Force COVID-19", item 7 emphasizes that the conduct of activities for the month of March shall be guided by the following:

a. All national activities involving learners and/or teachers requiring travel and congregation of various schools, divisions, and/or regions, except for National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) and National Festival of Talents (NFOT) are suspended and will remain so until further notice through an appropriate memorandum.

b. All regional activities involving learners and/or teachers requiring travel and congregation of various schools and/or division, including Regional Palaro (Regional Athletic Meets) are suspended, and will remain so until further notice through an appropriate memorandum.

c. All division and district activities that involve gathering/congregation of various schools in cities and municipalities where there have been DOH-confirmed local cases of COVID-19 are suspended and will remain so until further notice through an appropriate memorandum.

d. All division and district activities that involve gathering/congregation of various schools in cities and municipalities are highly discouraged.

2. In line with the aforementioned, the conduct of the **2020 Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association (CLRAA) Meet** on March 21-27, 2020 at Zambales Sports Complex, Iba, Zambales and its lined-up activities is suspended and will remain in effect until further notice.

3. Likewise, the conduct of Division Intensive Sports Training is suspended until an appropriate memorandum is issued.

4. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
