Learning Area Manager	EPS In charge/Focal Persons	<ol> <li>The Learning Area Manager shall:         <ol> <li>act as the over-all manager of the team;</li> <li>scout and select members of the team during the prewebinar process;</li> <li>delegate tasks to appropriate member;</li> <li>make sure of the adherence of the topics and competencies for the development of SLM/LAS according to its timeline;</li> <li>approve the learning competencies/critical contents according to the planned delivery and see to it that there is no overlapping grade level from other subject areas;</li> <li>call briefing and debriefing meetings if necessary;</li> <li>approve the materials to be used in the development phase.</li> </ol> </li> <li>lead the team in the development and evaluation processes.</li> </ol>
Writers	3 per learning area 1 for ALS, Kindergarten, MTB-MLE, SPED, Madrasah	The writer shall:  1. identify the appropriate learning competencies based on the needs of the learners on particular key stage;  2. coordinate and discuss the identified learning competency, with the learning area supervisor for approval;  3. gather materials for the learning resource to be developed;  4. work with the illustrator for the illustrations needed;  5. constantly coordinate with the learning area supervisor;  6. subject the finished material for quality assurance;  7. revise/edit as required;  8. submit the revised/edited copy to the layout artist for finalization.

Layout Artists	3 per learning area 1 for ALS, Kindergarten, MTB-MLE, SPED, Madrasah	The layout artists shall:  1. ensure that the output (online, offline) adheres to the LR standards and that it is free from any language and content error;  2. shall collaborate with the writer and the illustrator; and shall finalize the material following LR technical specification.
