2021 Musabaquah Skills Exhibition

(A Showcase of Talents and Skills in Arabic Language and Islamic Values)

- 1. The 2021 Division Musabaqah Skills Exhibition aims to provide the Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) learners with opportunities to showcase their skills and talents through exhibitions of their performance.
- 2. The Division Musabaqah Skills Exhibition is focused on the category: Qur'an Reading (Qiraatul Qur'an).
- 3. The Musabaqah showcasing of skills and talents is open to all learners attending ALIVE classes in the Public/Private Madaris/schools.
- 4. The participating school will send a five (5)-minute pre-recorded audio-video clip in video format: 1280x720 30fps Mp4 format of the conducted skills exhibition (Qur'an Reading) to Division ALIVE Coordinator as their official entry.

DESCRIPTION	This category will showcase the reading skills and developing good speech habits of Muslim learners. The Qur'an is the material to be used as it is an authentic source of stories and literature which is acceptable to all Muslims.	

I. Mechanics

- 1.1 Consent must be sought from the parents or guardian of the learner/participant.
- 1.2 During the training, only the coach, participant, accompanied by the guardian should be present in the area. Social distancing and wearing of face mask and face shield must be observed.
- 1.3 Each school will have one (1) participant in the Qur'an Reading category as a skill exhibition. The participants may either be male or female ALIVE learners, ages 9-12 years old.

- 1.4 The participant shall read the Suwar/Surah in Tarteel 'AL-QARIAH ".
- 1.5 The participant should have a copy of the Holy Qur'an for reading.
- 1.6 The participant should wear proper attire (black abaya and white hijab/kombong for female and white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/totob/kopya for male).
- 1.7 The participant shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surah.
- 1.8 Reading of the selected Surah shall be done within five (5) minutes.
- 1.9 Certificates of Recognition and Participation will be awarded to all the participants and coaches.

Criteria for Qur'an Reading

TOTAL	100%
Hay'ah/Stage Presence	10%
Sawt/Voice Clarity	20%
Tarteel/Chant	30%
Tajweed/Pronunciation	40%

- 1. Guidelines for identifying the Official Coaches:
 - a. he/she should be an alive teacher (permanent / cos); and
 - b. directly teach / train the contestant.
