**PROJECT RIGHT REVIEW INTENSIVELY GO AND HOPE FOR THE TOP:  
DIVISION ONLINE TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM**

1. Republic Act 7079 otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, declares that the policy of the State shall uphold and protect the freedom of the press even at the campus level and to promote the development and growth of campus journalism as a means of strengthening skills of ethical values, encouraging critical and creative thinking, and developing moral character and personal discipline of the Filipino youth.
2. Section 8 of RA 7079, further states that the Department of Education shall sponsor periodic competitions, press conferences and trainings/seminars in which student editors/writers and teacher-advisers of student publications in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels shall participate.
3. With the theme, *Pahayagang Pangkampus: Kaagapay sa Paghilom at Pagbangon ng Sambayanan* the Schools Division of Angeles City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall spearhead a five-day On line Training - Workshop on Campus Journalism on October 18-22, 2021 from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm.
4. The online training – workshop aims to:
  - 4.1 provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing as a career;
  - 4.2 update participants on the latest trends, approaches, and principles of journalistic writing in view of the new normal in education ; and
  - 4.3 promote the right to access information, knowledge, and data necessary to strengthen journalistic values in the new normal.
5. The participants to this webinar are the School Paper Advisers in English and Filipino and Campus Journalists from both public and private schools. Each school can send one School Paper Adviser and one Campus Journalist for English and Filipino. Meanwhile, Francisco G. Nepomuceno Memorial High School which is offering Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) can send all its eight teachers teaching SPJ.



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6. The delivery platform is via MS Teams. The link will be sent through the Public Schools District Supervisors for public schools and through Mr. Glenn Sarmiento, Education Program Specialist, In-Charge for Private Schools.
7. The opening program will be on October 18, 2021 at 8 o'clock a. m. All the participants are requested to log in 15 minutes before for the actual time of the online training and must observe proper dress code.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is earnestly desired.
