To: Heads of Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. Please be informed that the Schools Division of Angeles City, through the Angeles City Amateur Athletic Association will hold the "2021 Angeles City Amateur Athletic Association (ACAAA) Sports Skills Exhibition Contest".
- This activity aims to:
  - a. Provide an alternative venue for public and private school student-athletes to demonstrate their athletic abilities; and
  - b. Provide financial support to public and private schools, especially school sports organizations and sports activities, by giving monetary awards to the winners.
- 3. All participating teams shall strictly observe the safety protocols of the IATF and DOH in preparation for the participation in the 2021 ACAAA Sports Skills Exhibition Contest.
- 4. Submission of entries shall be on or before December 21, 2021. Likewise, judging of the submitted videos will happen on the same date.
- 5. Enclosed are the General Information and Mechanics on the conduct of 2021 ACAAA Sports Skills Exhibition Contest and List of Sports Events with number of Participants.
- 6. The presentation of winners will be held on December 27, 2021 via online platform.
- 7. All expenses related to the conduct of the said activity shall be charged to the 2021 SEF Annual Budget under Sports Development Programs subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance to the contents of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.

General Information and Mechanics on the Conduct of 2021 ACAAA Sports Skills Exhibition Contest

- 1. The contest shall be open to student athletes from both elementary and secondary schools currently enrolled in school year (SY) 2021-2022 are allowed to join.
- 2. The 2021 ACAAA Meet shall be managed by the Education Program Supervisor with the Tournament Managers and Technical Working Groups under the supervision by the Chief Education Supervisor of the School Governance and Operations Division.
- 3. The Skills Exhibition Contest shall be performed virtually via a recorded performance to comply with the IATF's regulations.
- 4. Participating groups shall submit a recorded entry of their performance in accordance with the standards for entry submission.
- 5. The Tournament Managers of the different sports events of public schools and private elementary and secondary schools shall oversee the identification and selection of student-athletes who will participate in the sports skills exhibition contest.
- 6. The different clusters of public schools and representatives from the private elementary and secondary schools shall be allowed to choose the event/s that they want to participate in.
- 7. The SGOD shall be aware of the current risk level classification in the local area as well as the guidelines in place based on the most recent IATF and local government guidelines on the implementation of community quarantine, to properly manage the team activities such as meetings, training, rehearsals, and taping, among others.
- 8. The decision of the judges shall be final; protests shall not be entertained.
- 9. Cash awards shall be awarded to the winners of the different events.
- 10. Participation cash allowances and uniform allowances shall be given to all participants.

#### A. Entries

- Entries containing the performances of teams shall be recorded.
- 2. Performances shall be done within a 3-minute time limit.
- Performances shall be accompanied by any genre of music or any musical instrument of choice as background. The use of vocal music with vulgar words is strictly prohibited.
- 4. The wearing of appropriate attire/uniform/costume shall be encouraged.

- The use of stage props or any paraphernalia and/or apparatus shall be allowed provided it will not cause any harm or post any risk for accident during the performance.
- Stunts and other forms of acrobatics such as pyramids, lifts, throws, among others that may cause any harm or accident during the performance is highly discouraged.

#### B. Venue

- Only those sports that need the usage of venues due to specialized equipment shall be encouraged to do so. While sports that may be videotaped at home shall be strongly recommended for student-athletes' safety.
- The competing teams shall use the school gym/stage or any venue or hall that has enough room, is clear of protruding items, and poses no hazard as site for training, rehearsals, and real filming or recording of entry.
- The venue shall follow the existing rules for the current risk level category, as set out by the local IATF.
- 4. The floor surface shall be flat and free from projecting items and covered with any material that is safe for the athletes to move on, such as puzzle mats or wrestling mats, if available.

#### C. Judging

- All entries shall be evaluated using a scoring system to be developed by the Organizing/Technical Working Committee.
- Contest mechanics and criteria for judging for each sports event shall be given by Tournament Managers to interested parties.
- Each judge shall independently record his/her score on every performance. Judges' score shall then be forwarded to the Head of the Board of Judges for his/her validation of the final score earned.
- The team that earned the highest score shall be declared the champion.
- Should there be a tie in the scores, the board of judges shall convene in a separate conference room to review the entries if necessary, and discuss, deliberate, and come up with a collegial decision and determine the winner.

#### Submission of Entries



The Division Tournament Managers shall submit the winning entries to the Division Technical Working Group on or before December 21, 2021.
