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- 1. The Schools Division of Angeles City, through the efforts of the Education Program Supervisor in SGOD, and in cooperation with the Division MAPEH Coordinators, will conduct a "Virtual Galaw Pilipinas, Galaw Angeleño Contest" on June 29, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 n.n.
- This activity aims:
 - a. to promote an active lifestyle for our learners and teachers that will benefit both their physical and socio-emotional well-being;
 - b. to improve strength, flexibility, cardio-vascular endurance, coordination, and balance;
 - c. to enhance cultural awareness by integrating Philippine cultures in the calisthenics exercises;
 - d. to inculcate nationalism, unity, and discipline; and
 - e. to produce a promotional video of the Division of Angeles City Wellness Program.
- 3. The contest is open to all learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel of all public elementary and secondary schools in the Schools Division of Angeles City.
- 4. Enclosed is the contest rules/mechanics and criteria for judging, committees, and calendar of activities.
- 5. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance to the contents of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.

CONTEST RULES/MECHANICS

- The participants must read DepEd Order No. 60, s. 2021 (Guidelines on Galaw Filipinas: The DepEd National Calisthenics Exercise Program.) https://www.deped.gov.ph/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/DO s2021 060.pdf
- 2. The competition is **open to all learners**, and teaching and non-teaching personnel of all elementary and secondary schools the Schools Division of Angeles City. There will be (3) categories, and these are the following:

CATEGORIES	A	B	C
COMPOSITIONS	K-3=15 + 4-6=15 30 Learners 1-Coach	JHS=15 + SHS=15 30 Learners 1-Coach or SHS – 30 (for SHS Stand Alone) 1-Coach	30 Teaching and Non- Teaching Personnel 1-Coach

- 3. All participants must be fully vaccinated and submit acceptable proof of vaccination.
- 4. Dancers must follow the IATF protocols.
 - a. proper distance of participants is at least 1-2 meters,
 - b. wearing of facemask is required during video presentation.
- 5. The entry video will be in landscape frame, with one (1) stationary camera set up (no zooming, no video mixing, must be fixed)
- 6. Participants need to observe the space they're moving that requires and **not being** out of the frame.
- 7. Participant must wear their respective school PE Uniform or any **appropriate** /comfortable attire such as jogging pants, t-shirts, and rubber shoes.
- 8. Virtual background, video effects, and props and equipment are prohibited.
- Participants will perform the Galaw Pilipinas Calisthenics Exercise with clear music and video recording. https://youtu.be/hmJQbCYEzFg Strictly follow the original steps and movements. There will be no entrance and exit music in the presentation.
- 10. All video entries must be submitted on or before June 24, 2022.
- 11. In case of tie, judges will decide and whatever decision made will be final and irrevocable.
- 12. There will be **one winner** for each Category (Categories A & B), **except in Category C** (Teacher's and Non-Teacher's Category), there will be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Placer.
- 13. A point deduction will be made for those who will violate the rules and mechanics.
- 14. The event will be held on **June 29, 2022** via FB Livestream / place to be announce later.
