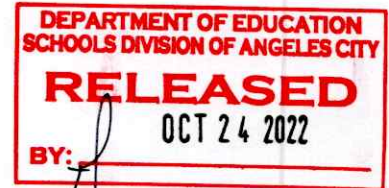



Mechanics and Criteria for the Search for Outstanding MEP Implementers

Mechanics:

1. The write-up must highlight the outstanding accomplishments and contributions within the last three school years.
2. Presentation of accomplishments must be in order, from the past to the present.
3. Participants must narrate the impact of their accomplishments on the implementation of MEP program and to the ALIVE learners.
4. Each entry may be written in English/Filipino/Maranao in A4 size bond paper with a minimum of 500 words: using Bookman Old style with 11 font size.
5. Supporting documents such as: project proposals, action plans, accomplishment reports with pictures, certificates of participation on different trainings and seminars, and certificates of recognition as coaches should be attached as means of verifications.

Criteria for Judging:

Outstanding Performance/Contribution - 40%

Impact of the Performance/Contribution - 40%

Consistency of Performance - 20%
