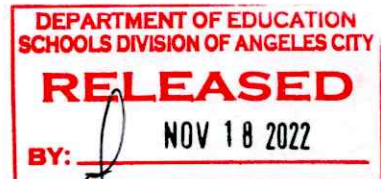

1. 2. This activity has the following objectives:

2.1. to plan for relevant and meaningful activities and ways for continuous improvement of school practices and processes on areas identified as dimensions of school operations, to wit:

- 2.1.1. Leadership;
- 2.1.2. Governance and Accountability;
- 2.1.3. Human Resources and Team Development;
- 2.1.4. Finance and Resource Management and Mobilization;
- 2.1.5. Curriculum and Instruction; and
- 2.1.6. Learning Environment.

2.2 to strengthen collaboration between RO and SDO in developing contextualized tools and mechanisms in the provision of TA to schools and prepare them in the challenges of school governance and SBM Validation;

2.3 to enhance the existing tools so that schools can continue in their self-assessment to identify areas for improvement in the aforementioned dimensions in SBM;

2.4 to enhance skills in providing technical assistance and its mechanisms as provided in RM 063, Series 2021; and



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- 2.5 to simulate the processes in providing impactful technical assistance with sharing of effective practices and mechanisms.
3. All School Heads, Assistant Principals, and Public Schools District Supervisors are the expected participants to this activity.
