2022 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

1. This is to announce the conduct of the 2022 Division Schools Press Conference, which will be held on December 3 and 10, 2022, via Google meet.
2. The conference aims to:
 - provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - enhance journalistic competence through friendly, individual and group competitions;
 - choose the participants who will represent SDO Angeles to the Regional Schools Press slated in January 2023.
3. All contest categories shall be held online via google meet except for the Radio and TV Broadcasting, where the contestants are allowed to be in their respective schools for the script writing, production and actual presentation of the outputs. The following are the different contest categories:

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4. Each public or private elementary and secondary school can send one (1) contestant per category in the Individual Writing Contests or a total of sixteen (16) campus journalists. Contestants from the secondary level may come from Junior or Senior High School.
5. For Radio Broadcasting, each school shall have two teams composed of five (5) members for the English and Filipino categories. Likewise, TV Broadcasting Team must also be composed of five (5) members, but it is a category intended only for High School contestants. The team members for TV and Radio Broadcasting should not be participants in any Individual Writing Contests.
6. Desktop Publishing contestants shall compose of five (5) members in English and Filipino for both Elementary and High School.
7. Photojournalism contestants can use any Digital Camera (point-and-shoot only) with a maximum of 24.3 megapixels. Contestants who use any DSLR and other high-end cameras will not be permitted to join the photo shoot.
8. There will be no registration fee. All expenses shall be charged to the Division HRTD Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. The submission of entries for the School Paper Contest in PDF format will be on or before January 3, 2023, and judging will be on January 4, 2023. Elementary school paper sizes are 9"x12" and secondary school paper sizes are 12"x18". The minimum and maximum number of pages are 12 and 20 respectively.
10. As stipulated in DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2005, teacher-participants who render services during the activity, which may fall on weekends, holidays, or non-working holidays are entitled to service credits. On the other hand, the non-teaching - participants shall earn Compensatory Time Off (CTO).
11. The opening program which will be attended by the school paper advisers only will be on December 3, 2022, at 8:00 a.m., while awarding ceremony will be on December 10, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. with this link: meet.google.com/qwn-ssqo-you
