

One of the key features of Republic Act No. 11713 or the Excellence in Teacher Education Act of 2022 is the recomposition of the Teacher Education Council (TEC) members. Section 7 of the law states that the Council shall be composed of nine (9) members, wherein five (5) shall serve in an ex-officio capacity by virtue of their respective offices:

1) Secretary of the Department of Education as Chairperson;

2) Chairperson of the Commission on Higher Education as Vice-Chairperson;

3) Director General of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority;

4) Executive Director of the National Commission of the Culture and the Arts;

5) Chairperson of the Professional Regulation Commission.

The remaining four (4) shall serve as regular members of the Council:

6) A teacher representative from a public basic education institution who is experienced and recognized as an expert nationally and internationally and whose personal and professional integrity as well as commitment to service are proven or well-accepted and endorsed by any public organization;

 A representative from an organization of deans of colleges of education, professional teachers and educators;

- 8) A representative from a national organization of private basic education institutions; and
- A representative from a national organization composed of school leaders from public or private basic education institutions.

Since March 16, 2023, the TEC Secretariat opened the call for nominations of the four regular members.

Relative to this and in accordance with Sec. 7(b) of RA No. 11713, we hereby request your good office to nominate

"a teacher representative from a public basic education institution who is experienced and recognized as an expert nationally and internationally and whose personal and professional integrity as well as commitment to service are proven or well-accepted".

The Secretariat will be accepting nominations until May 12, 2023.

Criteria for TEC Regular Member Teacher Education Council

Minimum Personal Qualifications

- .1. Must be a licensed teacher;
- 2. Must have integrity;
- 3. Must be willing to serve;
- 4. Must exhibit relevant expertise;
- 5. Must have experience in the education sector; and
- Must not have been convicted of any administrative offense or any crime involving moral turpitude and has no pending administrative and/or criminal case.

Documentary Requirements

Qualified applicants must submit one (1) set of certified photocopy, and one (1) electronic copy of the following documents to the TEC Secretariat:

- 2. Letter of Acceptance as official nominee of the organization
- 3. Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae, signed under oath;
- Certified true copy of documents in support of the data stated in the Curriculum Vitae;
- Nominee's Proposed Vision, Mission and Goals for Teacher Education Council;
- 6. Certificates/Clearances from the following government agencies, obtained not more than three (3) months from the date of filing of the application, indicating the applicant has no pending administrative and/or criminal case:
 - National Bureau of Investigation (NBI)
 - · Institution/Company where the applicant is presently employed
- 7. Duly accomplished CSC Form 212 made under oath;
- Certificate of Employment specifying the number of years in teaching and in administrative position or Service Record

Introduction

Under Republic Act No. 11713, the Teacher Education Council shall be composed of nine members that consist of five Ex-officio members and four TEC Regular Members. The law already identified that the Ex-officio members are the heads of the education agencies, particularly the Secretary of the Department of Education (DepEd) as the Chairperson of the Council, the Chairperson of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) as the Vice-Chairperson of the Council, the Director-General of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), the Executive Director of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and the Chairperson of the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC).

The TEC Regular Members should consist of four representatives (Sec. 7). The law specifies that there shall be a teacher representative from a public basic education institution who is experienced and recognized as an expert nationally and internationally and whose personal and professional integrity as well as commitment to service are proven or well-accepted; a representative from an organization of deans of colleges of education, professional teachers and educators; a representative from a national organization of private basic education institutions; and a representative from an organization composed of school leaders from public or private basic education institutions. The representatives shall be appointed by the President of the Republic of the Philippines based on the criteria given by the law (Sec. 7 b). The nominated representatives shall possess integrity, willingness to serve, and relevant expertise and experience in the education sector.

In the case of the TEC Regular Members, they shall undergo a selection process with three different phases. These are the Nomination phase, the Selection phase, and the Appointment phase. This selection process is the byproduct of the consolidated ideas from the three consultative meetings conducted on November 21-23, December 5-7, and December 12-14, 2022. This shall serve as the guidelines for forming the new Council under the new law.

SELECTION PROCESS OF TEC REGULAR MEMBERS

A. Nomination Phase

 The TEC Secretariat shall ask the different public and private organizations to nominate through writing one (1) official representative of the organization. These representatives are leaders of various public and private organizations of teachers, deans, school leaders, and administrators.

The following criteria shall serve as minimum requirement in selecting the nominee:

- 1. 1. Integrity;
- 1. 2. Relevant expertise;
- 1. 3. Experience in the education sector; and
- 1. 4. Willingness to serve.

However, each organization may provide additional criteria in selecting the nominee.

After receiving the formal notification, the organization shall be given 15 days to submit the official nominees to Secretariat's email address.

- The TEC Secretariat shall prepare the list of nominees from the different organizations.
- 3. The TEC Secretariat shall coordinate and endorse to the Search Committee for validation.
- 4. The TEC Secretariat shall communicate with the nominees and shall request the following:
 - 4.1. Letter of Intent expressing their vision as future member of the Council;
 - 4.2. Letter of Acceptance as official nominee of the organization;
 - 4.3. Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae; and
 - 4.4. NBI Clearance.

B. Selection Phase

- 1. The TEC Secretariat shall shortlist at least three representatives from different sectors in accordance with the Sec. 7 of RA No. 11713.
- 2. The TEC Secretariat shall coordinate with the organization of the nominees and conduct validation, verification of the documents.
- 3. The TEC Secretariat shall present the shortlisted organization to the Council for further review and deliberation.
- 4. The Council through the Chairman shall endorse the shortlisted nominees to the President to choose a representative for appointment.

C. Appointment Phase

The President of the Republic of the Philippines shall appoint the four (4) regular members of the Council.

Nomination Phase

- 1. The TEC Secretariat shall send a formal notification to the different public and private organizations regarding nominations for the new TEC Regular Members. The organizations shall submit in writing one (1) official representative within 20 days.
- 2. The TEC Secretariat shall prepare the list of nominees from the different organizations.
- 3. The TEC Secretariat shall coordinate and endorse to the Search Committee for validation.
- 4. The TEC Secretariat shall communicate with the nominees and request the following:
 - a. Letter of Intent;
 - b. Letter of Acceptance as official nominee of the organization;
 - c. Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae; and
 - d. NBI Clearance.

Selection Phase

- 1. The TEC Secretariat shall shortlist at least three representatives from different sectors in accordance with the Sec. 7 of RA No. 11713.
- 2. The TEC Secretariat shall coordinate with the organization of the nominees and conduct validation, verification of the documents.
- 3. The TEC Secretariat shall present the shortlisted organization to the Council for further review and deliberation.
- 4. The Council through the Chairman shall endorse the shortlisted nominees to the President to choose a representative for appointment.

Appointment Phase

The President of the Republic of the Philippines shall appoint the four (4) regular members of the Council.
