Project **SHIP** (**S**chool **H**eads **I**nduction **P**rogram): Orientation on different Administrative Services, Curriculum Implementation, and School Governance and Operations Cum Provision of Technical Support

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Division Chief Education Supervisors, Unit Heads Heads Public Elementary and Secondary Principals

- 1. Pursuant to Section 6.1, Rule VI of Implementing Rules, and Regulations of RA 9155 (Governance of Basic Education Act of 20021) states that there should be school head for all public elementary and secondary schools who is the person responsible for the administrative and instructional supervision of the school and expected to possess leadership dimensions. (Educational Leadership, People Leadership, and Strategic Leadership).
- 2. - 5. However, experienced school heads may join the activity on a voluntary basis.
