- 2. The objectives of the division roll out are:
 - 1. to capacitate school leaders in instructional leadership focused on a more holistic approach integrating literacy leadership, socio-emotional learning, and gender equity and social inclusion (CESI) in fostering conditions for a positive learning environment;
 - 2. to draft research-based and data driven project initiatives that will improve the learning outcomes of kindergarten to grade 3 learners in their respective schools;
 - 3. to support and compliment the implementation of national programs or initiatives such as, but not limited to, the National Learning Camp (NLC), the National Reading Program (NPR), and the National Mathematics Program (NMP); and
 - 4. to form linkages and share with other districts and schools some noteworthy practices aligned with the Instructional Leadership Training (ILT) principles.
- 3. The participants are all public elementary school heads, head teachers assigned in elementary schools, public schools district supervisors, EPS-Kinder and EPS-English and they are requested to bring laptops and extension cords.
