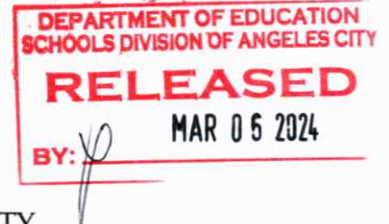

**2024 DIVISION INTENSIVE TRAINING FOR REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS  
(RSPC) PARTICIPANTS**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, SDO Angeles City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the conduct of the 2024 Division Intensive Training for the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) Participants on March 16, 2024 at Angeles Elementary School (AES ), Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
2. The intensive training aims to:
  - a. equip and deepen the knowledge, skills, and orientation of the campus journalists in preparation for the 2024 RSPC;
  - b. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches; and
  - c. improve the standing of SDO Angeles in the RSPC and NSPC.
3. The participants in this training are the First, Second, and Third Place winners in the Individual Writing Contests and the First Place winners in the Team/ Group Contests during the Division Schools Press Conference held last Jan. 29-30, 2024.
4. There will be no registration fee but schools will provide for the meals and transportation of their campus journalists and school paper advisers/ coaches to be charged to school MOOE/ Local/Canteen Funds. All the other expenses relative to the conduct of the intensive training shall be charged against Trust/Local Funds or the Campus Journalism Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The teacher-participants and non-teaching personnel are entitled to service credit for their attendance in this activity subject to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 known as "Updated Guidelines of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and Compensatory Time-Off and Overtime Credit in accordance to CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered."
