2025 SCHOOL PUBLICATION CONTEST CUM INTENSIVE TRAINING ON RADIO AND TV BROADCASTING

To: Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors, English and Filipino

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, SDO Angeles City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the conduct of the 2025 School Publication Contest Cum Intensive Training for Radio and TV Broadcasting on January 25 and February 1, 2025, at the Gabaldon Building, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. select the best school papers published by the elementary and secondary schools from both public and private; and
 - c. train the campus journalists on Radio Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting in preparation for RSPC.
- 3. There will be two parts in evaluating the school publications. An initial evaluation will be done on January 25, 2025, in which the evaluators will provide feedback and recommendations that the school paper advisers will consider. The final copy will be submitted for final review on January 30, 2025. The Top Five School Publications from among all entries will be chosen as SDO Angeles entries for the 2025 RSPC.
- 4. Aside from the school publication contest, intensive training for Radio and TV Broadcasting will also be conducted in preparation for the RSPC slated on February 26-27,2025 in Balanga City.
- 5. The participants in this activity are the DSPC First-Place winners in Radio and TV Broadcasting and the School Paper Advisers of each publication. A simple lunch will be provided to the participants.
- 6. The expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the DSPC Funds, Campus Journalism Funds, MOOE, or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
