- Please be informed that SDO Angeles City in coordination with the Junior Chamber International (JCI)- Angeles City "Culiat" will be Celebrating its 22nd Year of the Outstanding Senior-High Students of Angeles (TOSSA) for the School Year 2024-2025.
- The objective of the search is to acknowledge and appreciate the efforts of our 2. Senior High School Students in academics, leadership, compassion, and integrity.
- The criteria and mechanics of TOSSA for the S.Y. 2024-2025 are as follows: 3.
 - a. Grade 12 students from both public and private schools in Angeles City are qualified to join.
 - b. The number of nominees per school shall be based on the number of Grade 12 studens a school has:
 - a. One (1) nominee for a school with 300 or less Grade 12 students;
 - b. Two (2) nominees for a school with 301-600 Grade 12 students; and
 - c. Three (3) nominees for a school with more than 601 Grade 12 students.
 - c. All documents must be submitted together with an accomplished nomination form duly signed by the school head. All documents must be properly tabbed based on the criteria for evaluation.
 - d. The final grade in the first semester indicated in the School Form 9 shall be the basis for the scholastic standing of the nominees.
 - e. Achievement in Grades 11 and 12 shall be covered for extra-curricular activities.
 - f. All nominees are required to abide by the rules and regulations of the TOSSA Organizers.
 - g. A screening committee composed of the Department of Education, and Jaycees shall be organized while members of the Board of Judges shall come from various groups/sectors with the Schools Division Superintendent as the Chaiperson.









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- 4. The nomination form, criteria for valuation, and timeline for the search are enclosed in this Memorandum for your guidance and information.
- 5. All school heads of public and private schools in the Schools Division of Angeles City are enjoined to submit their nominees' application forms and documents to the Records Office on or before April 2025.
